General Data Protection Regulation Clerk's Update May 2018

Further to discussions at the last meeting:

- The HALC DP policy adopted has been tailored and is now on ETPC website
- As agreed, Cllrs Cutts and Nichols sit on the 'Data sub-committee'
- ETPC is not yet registered with the ICO as they require on-line payment.

 Councillors are requested to authorise Cllr Evison to pay personally and reclaim the £35 registration fee.
- The Government has tabled an amendment to the Data Protection Bill to exempt all parish and town councils and parish meetings in England from the requirement to appoint a Data Protection Officer (DPO) under the General Data Protection Regulation. However, HALC maintain that this is 'good practice' and the proposed revised Standing Orders require a DPO to be appointed.

Do Councillors wish to appoint a DPO?

- @parish.hants.gov.uk e-mails are no longer being issued. HALC have suggested setting up our own domain with 'Fasthosts'. This would cost a minimum of £1.99 per month. Do Councillors wish to continue using their current e-mail addresses, set up their own specific ones for PC business or to investigate other options?
