What others have done

In recent times, Hampshire Council in conjunction with Openreach created the county wide programme to enable Superfast broadband to increase broadband speeds to between 24-80Mbps. However, the Government has now tasked itself to push the country to adopt new technologies to bring in the new era of Gigabit speeds (1,000Mbps) to improve the digital economy, and create opportunities for all residents, civil societies & businesses.

We are in contact with Grayshott Parish Council to build a new fibre full Gigabit infrastructure in Grayshott, Headley Down, Hindhead as part of our Phase 1 rollout starting in Summer 2021. We are in liaison with Parish Councils and have had meetings and discussion on advertising and how we can work together to ensure that this new scheme benefits everyone in the locality.
