**CONSULTATION UNDER THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING  
(DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE ENGLAND) ORDER 2015**

**Applicant:** Mr Terry Brissenden

**Proposal:** Row of x8 mature sycamore trees (*acer pseudoplatanus*) and x1 mature beech tree (*fagus sylvatica*) and x1 mature ash tree (*fraxinus excelsior*) and x1 Norway maple (*acer platanoides*) along front of property opposite main gosport road to be crown lifted to approximately 5 to 6 metres from the ground. To meet requirements of highways safety close to road. Also crown lifted to same height on the internal side of the trees ( garden side) to maintain natural balance of the trees.

Tree identity Numbers:

1 to 8 = Sycamore trees (*acer pseudoplatanus*)  
9 = Ash tree (*fraxinus excelsior*)  
10 = Beech tree (*fagus sylvatica*)  
11 = Norway maple (*psuedo platanoides*)

X14 mature yew trees (*taxus baccata*) to be crown reduced back to previous pruning points to maintain shape and avoid breakouts and limb failure. All yews are located internally of the grounds. Row of approximately x5 yew trees run alongside road and will require crown lifting to meet highways safety regulations. Approximately 4 to 5 metres from the ground level up. Internally will require crown lifting to maintain the natural balance of the trees.

Approximately x4 yew trees will need reducing back to previous pruning points alongside the church to avoid damage and growth resting on the church itself.
